
Describing and Comparing Three Dimensional Shapes


In this worksheet, we will practice naming, describing, comparing, and sorting three dimensional shapes. Take a look at the lineup of shapes below, and then read about their characteristics.



| Shape | Characteristics |
|-------------------|---|
| Cube | Square faces, 8 corners, and 12 sides |
| Cylinder | Circle faces, no corners, and no sides |
| Sphere | No faces, no corners, and no sides; perfectly round |
| Rectangular Prism | Rectangle faces, 8 corners, and 12 sides |
| Cone | Circle face, 1 corner, and no sides |




