The German Major - Society and Culture Emphasis requires a minimum of 34 lower- and upper-division credits listed under GERM and approved departments (a maximum of 6 of these credits may be taken as approved HIST, CLCS, and/or POLS classes). It also requires either WLC 2010 or 2020 and a WLC Practicum Signature Experience for a total of $\mathbf{4 0}$ credits. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

This major is designed for students who come to the $U$ without a background in German. Students with previous German study or proficiency should instead take the German Major -- Advanced Language and Culture Emphasis. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 before any other upper-division courses in the major and the WLC Practicum Signature Experience (except for Learning Abroad) after all or most of the other courses in the major have been finished.
