The German Major - Society and Culture Emphasis requires a minimum of 34 lower- and upper-division credits listed under GERM and approved departments (a maximum of 6 of these credits may be taken as approved HIST, CLCS, and/or POLS classes). It also requires either WLC 2010 or 2020 and a WLC Practicum Signature Experience for a total of **40 credits**. At least 15 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR/NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

This major is designed for students who come to the U without a background in German. Students with previous German study or proficiency should instead take the German Major -- Advanced Language and Culture Emphasis. Students are encouraged to take WLC 2010 or 2020 before any other upper-division courses in the major and the WLC Practicum Signature Experience (except for Learning Abroad) after all or most of the other courses in the major have been finished. Email wlc-advising@utah.edu if a required course is not available or a potentially appropriate available course is not listed as an elective.
