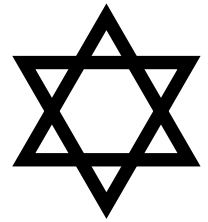


Judaism — Passover

What is Passover?



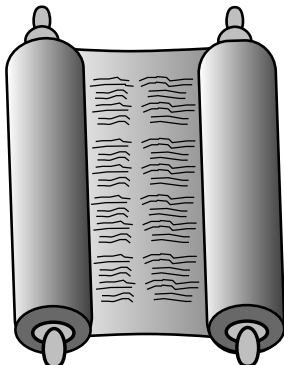
