Addition word problems (sums up to 10)

Answers:



Mini ate 6 ice-creams. Sam ate 2 ice-creams. How many ice-creams did they eat in total?

$$6 + 2 = 8$$



Martin plucked 4 apples. Later he plucked 5 more. How many apples did he pluck in total?

$$4 + 5 = 9$$



Alice brought 2 pencils. Her dad brought 7 more pencils for her. How many total pencils are there ?

$$2 + 7 = 9$$
