

Don't feel bad if you don't use all the sheets. Alternate and use different sheets the following year.




Parents are their child's first teacher. To make parents more involved with their child/ren's learning, print up 1 or more sheets to send home each week as home work. 😊

Community Helpers Flip Book



You can either bind the book or put rings on the top of the page to keep the book together. Sample shows the book binded.




- A police officer respond to 911 calls.



- A mail carrier picks up our mail.



- A doctor will give you medicine or a shot to make you better.


