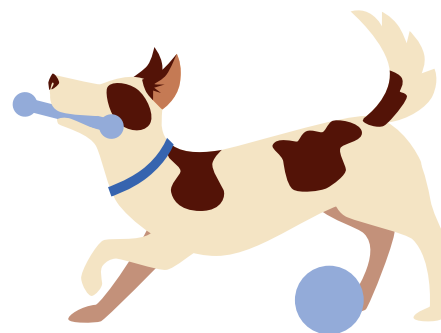


Possessive Noun Worksheet
