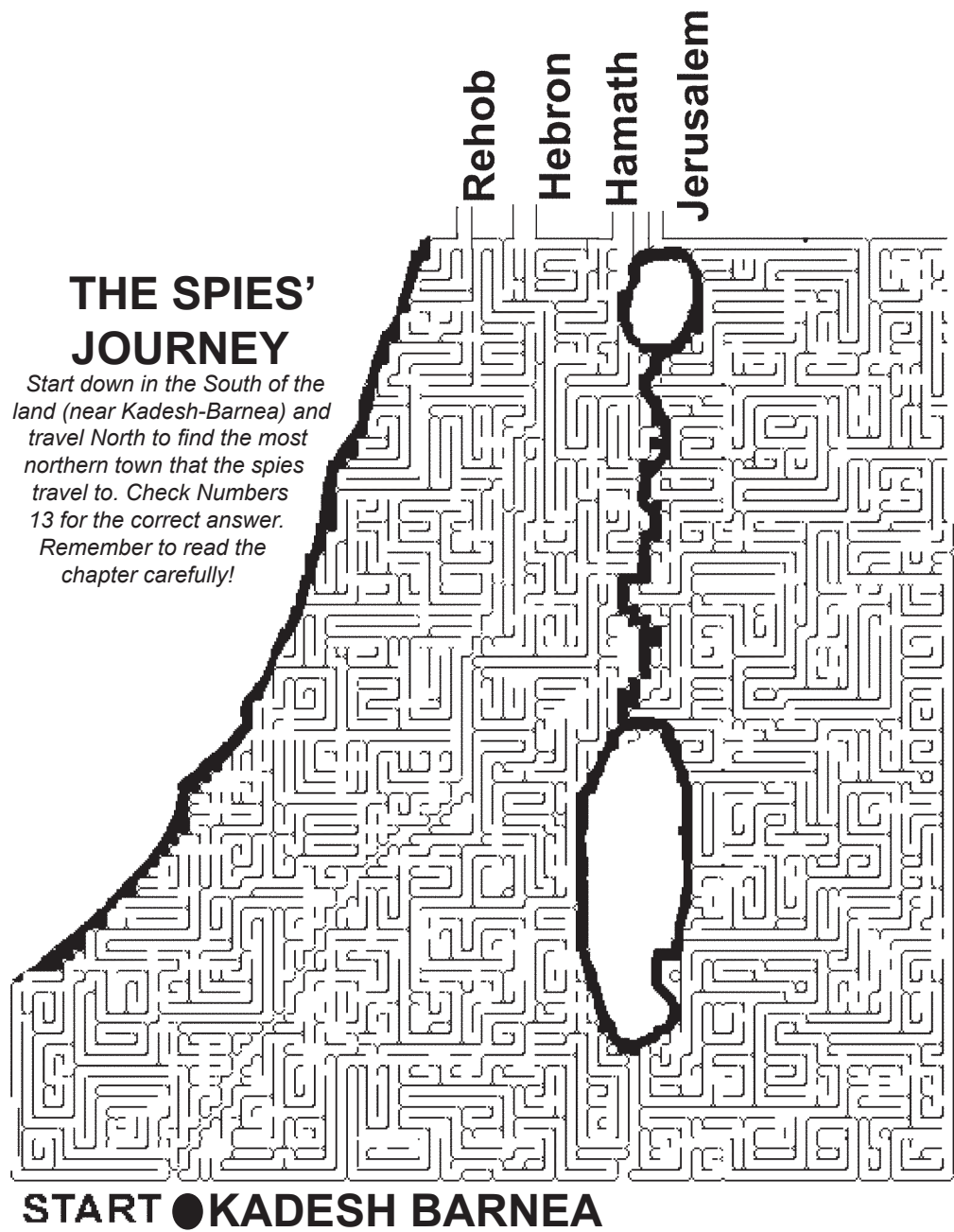


THE CAMP OF ISRAEL
