**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

The sequence of General Education courses is shown as an example only; they may be taken in any order.

General Education Policy allows a student to double count one Communications, Quantitative or Values course as one Group A, B, or C. If using this option, take one additional Free Elective.

Students who take ECONOMIC.156 rather than MATH.123 cannot use ECONOMIC.156 as a group C; they must take an extra

Group C in place of MATH.123 and reduce the free Electives by 3.

Total credits must equal 120 Consult advisor before selecting Business and Accounting Electives. Two of the courses selected for the Major, General Education OR Free Elective must also qualify as Diversity courses. See list of Diversity Courses and consult advisor.
