- Complete Documentation List
- Attend Dental Assisting Orientation

Dental Assisting is **NOT** a Limited Entry program. A “Limited-Entry Application for Admission to a Health Science Program” is **NOT** necessary to begin course work.

**PROGRAM PREREQUISITE COURSES:** These are college level courses that must be completed before a student is considered eligible for entry into the Program.
