

CONSONANT BLENDS

What are Consonant Blends?

Consonant blends are **two or more letters that work together**. When a word is sounded out, both of the letters in a consonant blend are heard. For example, in the word **small**, the **s** and the **m** are blended together in sounding out the **sm**.

Examples

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


